## About Nawada

Nawada is a district and town in southern Bihar, India, situated on the banks of the Khuri River. It serves as the administrative headquarters of the Nawada district, which was carved out of Gaya on January 26, 1973. The name "Nawada" is believed to be derived from the Persian word "Nau-abad," meaning "new town" or "new settlement." Historically, the region was an integral part of the ancient Magadh Empire, ruled by major dynasties such as the Mauryas, Guptas, and Palas. In the colonial era, the town was known as Eliot Market and was established as a subdivision of Gaya in 1845. Nawada is famous for the heavenly cold waterfall Kakolat, which is well developed and one of the attractive tourist spots in Bihar.

Nawada is bordered by Nalanda and Sheikhpura to the north, Jamui to the east, Gaya to the west, and the Jharkhand districts of Koderma and Giridih to the south. International tourist spot like Rajgir, ruins of Nalanda University, and Pawapuri are within 20 km from Nawada town. The district is drained by the Sakri, Khuri, Panchane, Bhusri, Tilaiya, and Dhanarjay rivers.
